Medical Consent for Matrons

From a medical point of view the Matron's main role is that of a 'mother'. As a rule Matrons do not have any medical qualifications. They treat minor illnesses, such as coughs, colds, bugs etc. as any mother would, turning for help to either nurses or doctors when needed.

Matrons will give out Paracetamol, Ibuprofen, simple cough linctus, indigestion remedies and other over-the-counter remedies under protocols from the School Doctor for treating minor ailments.

It is obviously very important that Matrons and the rest of the medical staff at the School are aware of any drugs, medicines or treatments that you would rather your child did not receive.
