Reception for Parents of First and Second Form Pupils  
Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2008

This year's Reception for parents of First and Second Form pupils will be held on the morning of Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> March. Such receptions provide an opportunity to discuss your son's or daughter's progress directly with those who teach them. All First and Second Form pupils will be given a booking sheet and will be arranging appointments for you to meet their teachers between 10.30 am and 12.30 pm.

I hope that you will be able to come to a meeting in The Stahl Theatre at 9.30 am on that morning, prior to the Reception itself, at which the Headmaster will address parents and the Director of Studies will talk about the transfer from the Second to Third Form.

Coffee will be served thereafter in the Arthur Marshall Room (AMR), next to the Great Hall, and I hope that parents will understand that appointments should not begin before 10.30am in order that pupils and staff may fulfil their other Sunday commitments. A copy of the completed form of appointments will be given to you on arrival at the AMR. Your son or daughter should communicate with you regarding the first appointment time nearer the 9<sup>th</sup> March.

Lapel badges (two per family) will be issued in the AMR; it helps us a great deal if parents wear these. We ask that you leave the badges at the door on your way out so that they can be used again.

After the Reception parents are invited to meet their son's or daughter's Tutor over drinks. Dr Holmstrom will be delighted to welcome parents to the Berrystead; Mr King invites Laxton parents to the Laxton Long Room.

The School Car Park is situated in the grounds of the Gascoigne Building (entrances in North Street and Blackpot Lane) and there are free car parks in St Osyth's Lane (behind the Xtra Supermarket near the Market Place) and at the Drill Hall in Benefield Road. There are also street spaces in New Street, Drummingwell Lane, Glapthorn Road and Milton Road. Please do not park in the grounds of Milton Road C of E Primary School.
