Reception for Parents of Lower Sixth Form Pupils
Sunday 24th February 2008

This year's Reception for parents of Lower Sixth Form pupils will be held on the morning of Sunday 24th February. Such receptions provide an opportunity to discuss your son's or daughter's progress directly with those who teach them. All Lower Sixth Formers will be given a booking sheet and will be arranging appointments for you to meet their teachers between 10.30 am and 12.30 pm.

The Headmaster would like to address parents prior to the Reception and since your son or daughter, later in the year, will be taking the important step of applying for a university place through the UCAS system, the Director of Studies and the Heads of Careers and Higher Education would welcome the opportunity to say a few words to you about the application procedure and courses. I hope therefore that you will be able to come to The Stahl Theatre at 9.30 am on that morning, before the Reception itself.

Coffee will be served thereafter in the Arthur Marshall Room (AMR), next to the Great Hall. In order for pupils and staff to fulfil their other Sunday commitments appointments will begin at 10.30am. A copy of the completed form of appointments will be given to you on arrival at the AMR. I hope that your son or daughter will be communicating with you nearer the 24th February, regarding the first appointment time. Lapel badges (two per family) will be issued in the AMR and I hope that parents will not mind wearing these. Could I ask you to leave the badges at the door on your way out so that they can be used again.

After the Reception, Housemasters and Housemistresses invite you to meet your son's or daughter's Tutor over drinks and a light lunch in Houses from 12.30 pm. Mr King invites Laxton parents to the Laxton Long Room. Cars may be left in our car park which is in the grounds of the Gascoigne Building; access from either Blackpot Lane or North Street (opposite the Berrystead). There are also unrestricted parking places in New Street, Drummingwell Lane, Glapthorn Road and Milton Road. I would ask you not to park in the grounds of Milton Road C of E Primary School.

I do hope that you will be able to attend.
