Attainment grades (1 - 5) reflect pupil performance in relation to teacher expectation and within the context of the performance of other pupils in the set.

1. Outstanding level of attainment
2. Consistently producing work of a very high standard
3. Good level of attainment
4. Attainment below expectations
5. Under-achieving. Unacceptable level of attainment

Effort grades (A – E) are used to indicate pupil effort in classwork and prep.

- A – Exceptional effort and commitment
- B – Consistently working very hard
- C – Good effort throughout
- D – Less than satisfactory effort
- E – Poor effort
