Further to my letter in January, I write to give further information about a Politics trip to Washington DC which I will be leading in February 2009, during the Easter Quarter Long Exeat. The plan is to leave School on Friday 6th February and return to the UK on the morning of Thursday 12th February.

I am happy for any current Lower Sixth pupil to take part in this trip, but it is particularly useful for those studying Politics at A2 level.

The trip will give a strong insight into US Government, which is the main topic covered by the A2 syllabus. We will include a visit to the following:

- Congress and the Library of Congress.
- The Supreme Court.
- The National Archive (including the Original Constitution and Declaration of Independence)
- The Smithsonian Museums.
- The White House.
- The Holocaust Museum.
- Mount Vernon (George Washington's Home)

We would also hope to visit a serving Congressman, some lobbyists (who are much in the news!) and the British Embassy.

The trip will cost in the region of £700 and will include all travel and Half Board Accommodation.
