SWIMMING POOL MEMBERSHIP

Membership Fees and Entrance charges for each occasion of Pool use.

Family £75.00. Additional Children £15.00.

Entrance charges - £3.50 per adult. £2.50 per child. £2.50 per Senior Citizen. Children under 5 free of charge.

Individual adult member is £52.00.
Entrance Charge - £3.50 per person.

Individual Student Membership £30.00.
Entrance charge - £3.50 per person.

Visitors entrance charge - £3.50 per adult. £2.50 per child.

Membership is valid for the year from the date of joining.

‘Family’ means the two parents/guardians and up to three children under 18 years of one family unit. Visitor’s who are staying with a member for at least one night, can accompany qualifying members of the family, for up to seven days, thereafter full membership must be obtained, entrance charges must be paid on each occasion.

“Qualifying members of the family” means family members aged 15 or over. They will be held responsible for their guest’s conduct and adherence to club rules.

Any student over 18 and who is still attending an educational establishment can obtain an individual membership. Proof of a student ID card or equivalent will be required before membership is issued.

New members are required to complete an application form, and agree to have their photograph taken and stored on the School system. Application forms are available at the swimming pool on request, or online www.oundleschoolenterprises.org.uk. Payment is to be made at the Pool or Sports Centre Reception.

All members agree to abide by Swimming Pool Rules. Breach of the rules, including behaviour which could cause offence or annoyance to other members in any way will result in the exclusion of a member. The decision of the School will be final in this respect. No refund will be made.

It will not be possible to give any compensation (e.g. extension of membership or cash refund) because of breakdown in the Pool or for any other reason.

The Governors of Oundle School accept no responsibility for loss or damage of any kind incurred by users of the Swimming Pool and associated facilities.

GENERAL RULES

FAILURE TO OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING RULES MAY RESULT IN THE OFFENDER BEING EXCLUDED FROM USING THE POOL.

1. All users of the Swimming Pool must **SHOWER** in the changing rooms before entering the pool for swimming.
2. Outdoor shoes must not be worn on the immediate surrounds of the Pool, but be placed in the shoe rack in the corridor. Only one piece costumes to be worn as per the School rules.
3. There must be no **INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR** of any kind, no **DUCKING, PUSHING IN, THROWING IN, UNNECESSARY SHOUTING** and **RUNNING** round the surround of the pool. **MASKS, FLIPPERS, AND INFLATABLES** are not allowed in the pool during general swim sessions.
4. The orders of the person in charge must be obeyed at once:

SIGNALS:

ON ALARM SOUNDING OR WHISTLE SOUNDING –

- **IMMEDIATE SILENCE**
- **LISTEN**
- **THOSE IN DEPTH OF WATER ALLOWING THEM TO STAND -STAND STILL**
- **THOSE OUT OF DEPTH – TREAD WATER OR SWIM QUIETLY TO THE SIDE.**

5. **SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED IN ANY PART OF THE BUILDING OR SCHOOL GROUNDS.**
6. **MOBILE PHONES MUST NOT BE USED IN THE POOL BUILDING.**

GENERAL RULES CONTINUED

7. FAMILY ADMISSIONS POLICY

A responsible person, aged at least 16 years, should accompany all children under the age of 10 and/or any non-swimmers into the swimming pool. They must be in the water with the children they are accompanying and maintain a constant watch over the children for whom they are responsible and maintain close contact with those children who are weak or non-swimmers. **The only exception to this is if the child has passed the ASA Pool Swimming Standard Award detailed below.**

- A responsible person must accompany children under 4 years of age into the water on a 1:1 basis. **The sole exception to this** is that 2 children under 4 years whether swimmers or non-swimmers can be accompanied by one person **if both children are wearing armbands or other approved buoyancy aids. If in doubt please enquire with pool staff. All children in armbands must stay in the designated area.**
- Children aged 4-7 years must be accompanied into the water by a responsible person on a maximum 2:1 basis.
- Children over 10 years of age may be admitted and swim unaccompanied if they have passed the ASA Pool Swimming Standard Award. They can be tested by the lifeguards and this will be recorded within their computerised membership details.
- Children over 8 years may swim unaccompanied with a responsible person spectating if they have passed the ASA Pool Swimming Standard Award as above. They can be tested by the lifeguards and this will be recorded within their computerised membership details.
- Children over 15 years who hold the ASA Swimming Standard Award may bring a guest if the Lifeguard is satisfied with the guest's swimming ability.

8. All members of the Swimming Pool enter Oundle School premises entirely at their own risk and the Governing Body and their agents accept no responsibility for loss or damage to member's property or for any accident or personal injury that may occur to them whilst exercising their membership of the Club.
