OO Network Terms of Service

The OO Network (<u>www.oonetwork.org.uk</u>) is an online platform provided by the Oundle Society and the Old Oundelian Club with the support of a third-party supplier.

It is offered so as to enable OOs to contact one another straightforwardly in a trusted environment, to share news, to organise events and gatherings, and to facilitate connections which may assist OOs in their career development and/or enable you to offer such assistance to others within the community.

It may be used to advertise and/or to solicit activities, items and services considered to be of interest to the wider community. Advertisements considered acceptable include the use of holiday accommodation, chargeably or otherwise, charitable endeavours, articles and items relating to the history of the School, and events with some sort of a connection to Oundle.

It may not be used routinely for the advertisement of a primary business and/or the services of your employer, for the sale or solicitation of unrelated personal property such as cars, houses, and other items, or to advertise events for which it is difficult to discern an immediate appeal to Oundelians in particular.

It may be used for the formation of group discussions on any relevant topic, but may not be used to disparage the School or in any way which may, in the School's judgement, harm its reputation. Reasonable enquiries and debate will be tolerated, but the School reserves the right to intervene in such discussions with an official response and/or to close the discussion to new contributions.

The Oundle Society reserves the right to remove any content considered by the Director of Development, a member of their team, and/or any other member of the School staff, Governing Body, or OO Club Committee, to be inappropriate.

These terms of service supplement and are in addition to the Terms of Use of the website itself, which governs the relationship between you and our provider. Where there is any conflict, those Terms of Use take precedence.
