A SHORT HISTORY OF THE SOCIETY

The **Old Oundelian Golfing Society** was formally founded in 1930, so that a team could enter the Halford Hewitt, with Ernest Stacey as Hon. Secretary, but of the pre-War period there are only fragmentary records. A Challenge Cup seems first to have been competed for in 1907 at Oundle, but this competition only survived for four years, and it was not until a second trophy was presented in 1927 that competitions restarted. The original trophy then became the Scratch Cup and the new one the Handicap Cup. These have been competed for annually since 1927, with the exception of the War years 1940 - 1947.

In the pre-War years, the Society seems basically to have been made up of those who were available for the Halford Hewitt and such competitions which took place would have been played at Oundle GC in the days when it was a nine-hole course, maintained by voluntary labour, with sheep and cattle on fairways and wire fences around some of greens. Much of the organisation would have been in the hands of P.G. Coombs (S 1910) who was Secretary and Treasurer of the OO Club for 41 years and Secretary of Oundle GC.

Post-War, the Society was formally reconstituted with Charles Sutcliffe as Hon. Secretary at the meeting convened by Ernest Stacey at Grosvenor House, London on November 25th, 1947. Rules were drawn up in conformity with the requirements of the Public Schools Golfing Society and a modest annual subscription of five shillings was agreed. This was raised to ten shillings in 1952, where it remained until 1970.

In 1949 the membership of the Society was roughly 30 and Oxford and Cambridge golf Blues from Oundle had been something of a rarity. The membership today stands at around 200, golf has become a school sport and fourteen Blues have been obtained by OOs since the war: in 1952 two OOGS members were on opposite sides in the University Match at Rye GC – Duncan Gorrie (C 1945) played for Oxford whilst Tony Riley (Ldr 1947) wore the light blue of Cambridge. 25 years later in 1977, when, for the second time, Peter Pentecost (St A 1973) represented Cambridge, at Royal Porthcawl GC, Jeremy Monroe (G 1973) was in the Oxford side. The latest member of this ‘club-within-a club’ is George Crawley (L 2020) who won his singles match for Cambridge at Royal Dornoch in March 2023.

OOGS’s first entry (as Oundle) into the **Halford Hewitt Cup** was in 1931, seven years after the competition’s inception. With the help of Dr. Kenneth Fisher, Headmaster of the School at the time, the Captain, W.H. Bermingham, then an undergraduate at Cambridge and probably Oundle’s first Oxbridge Blue, raised a side which beat Aldenham in the first round, but bowed out to Repton in the second.

After the War, OOGS did not play in 1947, for reasons now forgotten, but reached the Quarter Finals in 1948. This unexpected success did not lead to further triumphs, indeed the Society only got through 3 rounds between 1949 and 1959. However, in 1960 Oundle reached the Semi Finals for the first time, losing to a strong Fettes team. Building on this success, the Quarter Finals were again reached in 1961, losing to the eventual winners Rossall, who had also won the previous year. These two successful campaigns suggested that Oundle might become more confident of progress in future years, as a team had been assembled which included three good experienced players – Ken Frazier (who played for England in 1938, the only OO so far to achieve this), John Tullis and Mac Hayward – along with five recruits under the age of 25, namely, Neil Roberts, Tim Illingworth, Roger Christian (G 1956), David Simons (Sn 1959) and Noel Stephens (St A 1959) – these last three, along with Mac Hayward, all Oxbridge Blues. Under Ken Frazier’s inspiring

leadership, the team won the Halford Hewitt for the first time in 1962, beating Stowe in the final in brutal weather conditions. A firmly hit seven-foot putt in the gale by Graham Phillips sealed the win, after he and David Simons had been one down with two to play. A trophy inscribed with the names of the winning team members, the Stacey Salver, was competed for subsequently in the House Competition at the Society's Annual Weekend.

35 years later, in 1997, Oundle once again triumphed, beating Harrow in the final, under the captaincy of Nick Copestick (Ldr 1969). This was an experienced side, the majority of whom had played together in the tournament for over 20 years, and which boasted four Oxbridge Blues – when the chips were down in the Semi-Final against Watson's and later the same day in the Final, vital points were gained under intense pressure. Throughout the six rounds, two pairs remained unbeaten: Robert Barrell (St A 1961) & Steve Carr (S 1984) and Peter Pentecost & Nick Copestick. Playing in the top pair, Iain Henderson (LS 1985) & Ross Morrison (N 1980) won four points out of six, results matched by Jeremy Monroe & Mark Eddy (St A 1984). No one watching will forget the way these two played the last, deciding hole: Jeremy's dead straight drive and Mark's laser-like 4 iron from 216 yds to within 18 ft of the pin. Three players contributed to pair five: Nick Owles (N 1963), John Denham (Sn 1968) and Fred Domellof (Lx 1976), calming nerves by winning important points. A magnificent dinner in the Grocers' Hall was organised later that year to celebrate the team's success, enjoyed by all the team and many other OOGS members and guests.

Commemorative Shields for each of the two wins, inscribed with the names of the team members, hang in the clubhouse of Luffenham Heath GC. In 1981, to celebrate 50 years in the tournament, silver wine coasters were presented to the two clubs which host the competition by the then President, Sam Pickles.

In 2014, Robert Barrell became the first member of OOGS to play 100 matches in the Halford Hewitt, which milestone was rewarded by the presentation of a silver salver from the Halford Hewitt Committee and a specially commissioned painting from his teammates, past and present.

In 2024, 15 OOGS members attended the Halford Hewitt Centenary Dinner at The Grosvenor House Hotel, London. The second book to be published about the tournament, celebrates 101 years, is now in circulation: 'A Touch of Class' will follow 'A Festival of Foursomes' as a collectors' item and one to be treasured. It contains many references to the achievements of OOGS over the years.

OOGS takes part in other Public Schools tournaments which later grew out of the Halford Hewitt: the Grafton Morrish and The GL Mellin Salver; whilst there is a Scottish version, the 'QE': *details of OOGS records in these events can be found later in this Booklet.*

There are also over 25 fixtures or meetings in which OOGS participates annually: more information can be seen in the annual Fixture List.

OOGS celebrated its **Golden Jubilee** in June of 1980 with many members meeting at Oundle GC for 36 holes of competition followed by a dinner at the Great Hall, Oundle School.

Competitions at an Annual Golf Weekend were first played at **Luffenham Heath GC** in 1948 and have been held there every year since. The Society is fortunate to have such a welcoming club at which to stage this meeting in October, and all the Oundelians who visit there enjoy playing on such a splendid course which has been much upgraded in recent years. Indeed, Oundle and other schools contributed via donations and membership to the reconstruction of the course after the war, when some holes had been incorporated into an airfield. Several trophies are now played for on this occasion. Up to around 40 members normally attend the weekend, dining at the George Hotel in Stamford.

A round of golf was enjoyed by fewer golfers than usual at the 2020 Annual Weekend during the global COVID-19 pandemic, maintaining an unbroken run of 74 years' play since activities resumed following WW2.

RULES OF THE SOCIETY (Amended 2021)

1. The name of the Society shall be the Old Oundelian Golfing Society.
2. The objects for which the Society is established are to foster the traditions and playing of the Royal and Ancient Game of Golf and to conduct the affairs of the Society to these ends.
3. The membership of the Society shall be confined to members of the OO Club.
4. Application for membership shall be made to the Honorary Secretary on the prescribed form.
5. Members shall pay an annual subscription, except for members under the age of 23 who shall enjoy free membership. Any member whose subscription is in arrears for more than two years shall ipso facto cease to be a member of the Society and can only be re-admitted upon application to, and at the discretion of, the Committee. The Committee may grant Honorary Membership.
6. The Society shall hold annually a General Meeting of which three weeks' notice in writing shall be given to members at the addresses registered in the records of the Society. Six shall form a quorum at General Meetings.

The Annual Meeting shall be held at such time and place as may be prescribed by the Committee, for the transaction of the following:

- i) To take part in the annual golf competitions
- ii) To consider the Report and Accounts for the preceding year.
- iii) To elect the following Officers:
The President,
Vice-Presidents,
The Honorary Secretary,
The Honorary Treasurer.
- iv) To elect two members to serve on the Committee for a 4 year term. These members are eligible for re-election after one year.
- v) To propose Area Secretaries and Captains, as deemed desirable, to be ex-officio members of the Committee.
- vi) To determine the rate of subscription.
- vii) To present the prizes.
- viii) Any other business.

Notice of every motion to be submitted to the Annual General Meeting shall be in writing, signed by the proposer and seconder and sent to the Hon Secretary ten clear days before the meeting.

7. The management of the Society shall be vested in the Committee who shall have full control of the administration of its affairs and the election of its members. Five shall be a quorum for Committee meetings at which either the President or Hon Sec must be present.
8. The Society ties, introduced in 2019, shall consist of the School colours in stripes on a green background. Members who have represented the Society in the Halford Hewitt may alternatively wear the tie with School colours in stripes on a blue background.
9. Data Protection Act: OOGS will only use members' contact details for communication within the Society's activities.
10. The Rules of the Society can only be changed at a General Meeting.

THE HALFORD HEWITT CUP

The pre-eminent Public Schools Old Boys tournament, founded in 1924, it is competed for today by the alumni of 64 schools and is a knockout tournament for five foursomes pairs in each team, played at Royal Cinque Ports GC and Royal St. George's GC. OOGS first fielded a team in 1931.

THE GRAFTON MORRISH TROPHY

OOGS first entered in 1964, the year after the inaugural competition. Around 160 teams from The Public Schools Old Boys Society attempt to qualify each year in regional events for a place in the finals, which take place at Hunstanton GC and Royal West Norfolk GC (Brancaster) in October. OOGS currently plays in the qualifying tournament at Denham GC in May each year. 48 teams compete in the finals, playing scratch foursomes in three pairs.

Oundle has competed in over 40 finals tournaments: we had 15 years of consecutive qualification between 1973-1987.

Most matches played by an OOGS member: Robert Barrell with 74 matches. He is also our highest points gatherer with 44 points; Martin Vincent (Lx 1956) is OOGS' next best scorer with 29½ points. In the three years 1973 to 1975, playing in the top pair, Robert and Martin won 13½ points out of 14!

The highest win ratio (minimum 20 matches) in OOGS has been achieved by Steve Carr with a 66% success rate.
