
Visitor Protocol: COVID-19

In line with the national lockdown restrictions and the government's announcement of school closures, we are only permitting essential visitors onsite. In addition, we are requiring all visitors **not to enter the School site** in the following circumstances:

- 1. If they have been advised by their GP or hospital clinician to either stay at home or leave their home only under limited constraints.**
- 2. If they or any member of their household or support bubble have tested positive for COVID-19.**
- 3. If they or any member of their household or support bubble are showing symptoms and are currently waiting for a test or for test results.**
- 4. If they have been contacted by NHS Test and Trace and advised to self-isolate.**
- 5. If they have recently entered the UK from another country and are required to follow the current quarantine guidelines in place.**

All visitors should also note the following:

Prior to your arrival, you will be issued with the School's 'Information for Visitors', which provides information on safeguarding, fire safety, first aid and parking arrangements.

On arrival, you will be asked to sign in and be provided with a visitors' identification badge which should be worn throughout your visit and returned to your host when you sign out.

You will be required to observe the guidelines on social distancing, hand and respiratory hygiene measures, face coverings and all other signage, floor markings and displayed instructions in place at the buildings and locations you are visiting.
