
Visitor Protocol: COVID-19

While we are pleased to have been able to lift many of the previous constraints, our protocol reflects the temporary measures introduced by the Government's Autumn and Winter Plan B.

We request that visitors **do not to enter the School site** in the following circumstances:

- 1. If they have tested positive or are showing COVID-19 symptoms and are currently waiting for test results.**
- 2. If they have been identified by NHS Test and Trace as a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case and are not exempt from the requirement to self-isolate.**
- 3. If they have recently entered the UK from another country and are required to follow the current quarantine guidelines in place.**

All visitors should also note the following:

Prior to your arrival, you will be issued with the School's 'Information for Visitors', which provides information on safeguarding, fire safety, first aid and parking arrangements.

On arrival, you will be asked to sign in and be provided with a visitors' identification badge which should be worn throughout your visit and returned to your host when you sign out.

All staff, pupils and visitors are required to wear a face covering when moving around in corridors and communal areas of the School. **We also politely ask you to undertake an LFD home test within 24 hours prior to your visit and continue to observe good hand and respiratory hygiene throughout your visit.** Should your LFD test prove positive, please re-arrange your visit with your host and follow the national guidelines currently in place.
